

TOWN-WIDE CLEAN-UP DAY

The Township in conjunction with the Clean Communities Program (funded by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection) will hold a **TOWN-WIDE CLEAN-UP DAY** on Saturday, October 18, 2008. The Township has set aside this day for residents to “catch-up” on cleaning around the house. To assist you in your efforts, special hours have been established at the Parsippany Recycling Center located off of Route 46 East. The center will be open from 8:00 am-3:00 pm. Items that can be brought to the Recycling Center include: all recyclables, yard waste, junk mail, corrugated cardboard, TV’s and all electronics, radio and car batteries, motor oil (3 gallons per resident), concrete, tree stumps (no longer than 3 ft.), magazines, tires (without rims), empty latex paint cans, and construction debris. Proof of residence will be required to enter the recycling center. Acceptable forms of identification include tax, water and sewer bills, or a driver’s license. **NO commercial vehicles are allowed in the recycling center. NO out-of-town vehicles. Vehicles must be registered in Parsippany.**
