

ORDINANCE NO. 2015:11

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 290, PARKS, RECREATION AREAS AND PUBLIC LANDS, ARTICLE II, USE REGULATIONS; PERMIT REQUIREMENTS OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PARSIPPANY-TROY HILLS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Parsippany-Troy Hills, County of Morris and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 290, Parks, Recreation Areas and Public Lands, Article II, Use Regulations; Permit Requirements, Section 8, Permits of the Code of the Township of Parsippany-Troy Hills is hereby amended and supplemented by the following:

A. **§ 290-8. Permits, F. (1) *Recreational Activities.***, shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced as follows:

Various Tennis programs and memberships (per person)	\$5 - \$150
Trips, special events and programs	Cost rounded to highest dollar amount

B. **§ 290-8. Permits, F. (2) *Facility Use.***, shall be amended and supplemented by deleting the description *League/Business Use* and further defining this category as *Township and Out of Township Business Use* and establishing fees for same. This section shall read as follows:

(2) Facility Use.

Natural grass fields (per hour)
With Lights

League/Business Use – Township	\$45
League/Business Use – Out of Township	\$90

No Lights

League/Business Use – Township	\$23
League/Business Use – Out of Township	\$45

Artificial turf fields (per hour)
With Lights

League/Business Use – Township	\$60
League/Business Use – Out of Township	\$120

No Lights

League/Business Use – Township	\$30
League/Business Use – Out of Township	\$60

C. **§ 290-8. Permits, F. (2) Facility Use.**, reference to the **Activity Center, indoor (per hour)** and the description under **Note:** shall be deleted in its entirety.

D. **§ 290-8. Permits, F. (2) Facility Use., Picnic Area Rental;** shall be amended and supplemented by the addition of the groups *Business – Township* and *Business - Out of Township* and establishing fees for same. This section shall read as follows:

Picnic area rental; fees include garbage pickup service (per group)

Business – Township (number of people in group)

15 to 50	\$75
51 to 100	\$150
Over 100	\$225

Business – Out of Township (number of people in group)

15 to 50	\$150
51 to 100	\$300
Over 100	\$450

E. **§ 290-8. Permits, F. (2) Facility Use., Picnic Area Beer Permit (per event)** shall be amended and supplemented by the addition of two groups *Business – Township* and *Business - Out of Township* and establishing fees for same. The word Beer in the title shall be replaced with Alcohol. This section shall read as follows:

Picnic area alcohol permit (per event)

Business – Township	\$100
Business – Out of Township	\$200

F. **§ 290-8. Permits, F. (2) Facility Use., Veterans Memorial Park bandstand** shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

Veterans Memorial Park Bandstand (per hour) with electricity and lights	\$125 (4 hr. min. required)

G. **§ 290-8. Permits, F. (2) Facility Use., Basketball Court, per court (per hour)** shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

Basketball Court (per court, per hour)

Business – Out of Township	\$15

H. **§ 290-8. Permits, F. (2) Facility Use., Tennis Court, per court** shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

Non-Resident	\$10
Business – Township	\$8
Business – Out of Township	\$15

SECTION 2. Chapter 290, Parks, Recreation Areas and Public Lands, Article II, Use Regulations; Permit Requirements, Section 16, Fees for Special Services of the Code of the Township of Parsippany-Troy Hills is hereby amended and supplemented by the following:

A. **§ 290-16. Fees for Special Services** shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

The hourly fee for special services provided by Parks and Forestry employees, outside of regular working hours, shall be \$58 per hour, per employee. A minimum of two employees and a minimum of four hours shall be charged.

SECTION 3. Chapter 290, Parks, Recreation Areas and Public Lands, Article II, Use Regulations; Permit Requirements, Section 19, C. Rental fees for Township-sponsored events and festivals of the Code of the Township of Parsippany-Troy Hills is hereby amended and supplemented by the following:

A. **§ 290-19. C. Rental fees for Township-sponsored events and festivals** shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

C. Each application to erect any tent, table, display, advertisement, booth or concession during any Township-sponsored event or festival in any Township right-of-way or upon any Township street, sidewalk, or property shall be accompanied by a fee determined pursuant to the following table.

SECTION 4. If any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof.

SECTION 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Township of Parsippany heretofore adopted that are inconsistent with any of the terms and provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
