NOTICE OF INTRODUCTION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the following Ordinance was submitted in writing at a Meeting of the Township Council of the Township of Parsippany-Troy Hills, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, held on **July 21, 2015** introduced and passed on first reading and the governing body will further consider the same for second reading and final passage thereof at a Meeting to be held on **August 18, 2015** at 7:30 p.m., prevailing time, or as soon thereafter as the matter may be reached, at the Municipal Building in said Township at which time and place a Public Hearing will be held thereon by the governing body, and all persons and citizens in interest shall have an opportunity to be heard concerning same. A copy of this ordinance has been posted on the Bulletin Board in the Municipal Building. During the week prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting, copies of said Ordinance will be made available at the Clerk's Office in said Municipal Building to the members of the general public who shall request the same.

TOWNSHIP OF PARSIPPANY-TROY HILLS MORRIS COUNTY, NEW JERSEY ORDINANCE NO. 2015:19

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PARSIPPANY-TROY HILLS, MORRIS COUNTY, NEW JERSEY CREATING CHAPTER 354, ARTICLE VI, MUNICIPAL WASTE RECEPTACLES, OF THE CODE OF TOWNSHIP OF PARSIPPANY-TROY HILLS

WHEREAS, the Township of Parsippany-Troy Hills (the "Township") regulates the disposal of waste; and

WHEREAS, the Township provides and maintains receptacles located in public places for the disposal of small amounts of garbage and recyclable materials by pedestrians and visitors to said public places; and

WHEREAS, in order to promote the health, safety and welfare of its residents, the Township desires to limit the amount of waste and recyclable material that may be deposited in and around its receptacles.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Parsippany-Troy Hills, Morris County, New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 354, Article VI of the Township Code, Municipal Waste and Recycling Receptacles, is hereby created as follows:

Section 354-34, Amount of waste and recyclable materials limited

- A. No person, business, or entity shall deposit more than one (1) cubic foot of garbage or recyclable material per day into any waste or recycling receptacles owned or maintained by the Township.
- B. It shall not be unlawful to deposit into waste or recycling receptacles owned or maintained by the Township any small amounts of garbage, trash, rubbish, litter, or recyclable material generated locally in the course of travel including, but not limited to, individual newspapers, food, individual retail beverage and food containers and wrappings, and other similar containers.
- C. Nothing herein shall limit the amount of waste or recyclable material that may be deposited at any Township municipal yard or transfer station.

Section 354-35, Outside waste, recyclable materials, municipal and commercial waste prohibited

- A. No person, business, or entity shall bring any waste, garbage, litter, refuse, rubbish, municipal solid waste, medical waste, or other waste or recyclable material into the Township for the purpose of disposing of the same in any waste or recycling receptacle owned or maintained by the Township.
- B. No person, business, or entity shall deposit municipal solid waste or commercial garbage or recyclable material into any waste or recycling receptacle owned or maintained by the Township, except as provided in this Chapter.

Section 354-36, Enforcement

This Article shall be enforceable by any member of the Police Department, the Director of Public Works or his designee, or the Health Officer or his designee.

Section 354-37, Violations and penalties

- A. Any person convicted of a violation of this Article is subject to a fine of not more than \$2,500 for a first offense, and not more than \$10,000 for a second and every subsequent offense.
- B. Each day during which the violation continues shall constitute an additional, separate and distinct offense

- C. If a person is convicted of a violation of the provisions of this Article, the court shall, in addition to the penalties provided herein, require the person to perform community service for a term of not more than 90 days.

SECTION 2. All actions of the Township taken prior to the date of adoption hereof contemplated by this Ordinance are hereby ratified and approved.

SECTION 3. If any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part thereof.

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Township of Parsippany-Troy Hills heretofore adopted that are inconsistent with any of the terms and provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
