After twenty (20) years of service			
After twenty-five (25) years of service			
SECTION 4			
In the event any position in Sections 1 or 2 above becomes vacant, any replacement may be hired within the above designated ranges.			
SECTION 5			
All items in this ordinance are considered pensionable earnings.			
SECTION 6			
This ordinance shall be retroactive to January 1, 2016 for all employees active on the date of introduction of this ordinance.			

SECTION 7			
This ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
